And changed the entire look of the front entrance, while tying it in to the addition and capping it off with a metal roof.








Here is the final result.

Brand-new black windows and these matching steel doors were installed throughout the home.




Here is the master bathroom, which was the addition. We also installed reclaimed beams from the Belleview Biltmore in this room.





The master bathroom included some unique, custom tile work and the black-and-white color scheme.








There were a number of other unique and beautiful details throughout the home.
